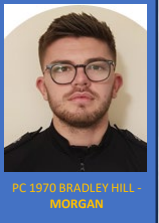

Priorities for the area and updates

- **Anti-Social Behaviour**

Bus station, High St, Cambrian Rd. Hotspot policing.

- **Commercial Burglaries**

- **Op Forester**

- **Night Time Economy**

New model now in place with the inclusion of licensing officers, NPT and response officers. Figures show a reduction in nearly all violent crime types for this period.

Partnership with Pubwatch/ NTA

- **Shoplifting**

LPA priority- Retail Crime Team. National trend.

Retrospective facial recognition software now in place as standard practice. Repeat offenders treated as a daily priority. More timely arrests and greater demand reduction.

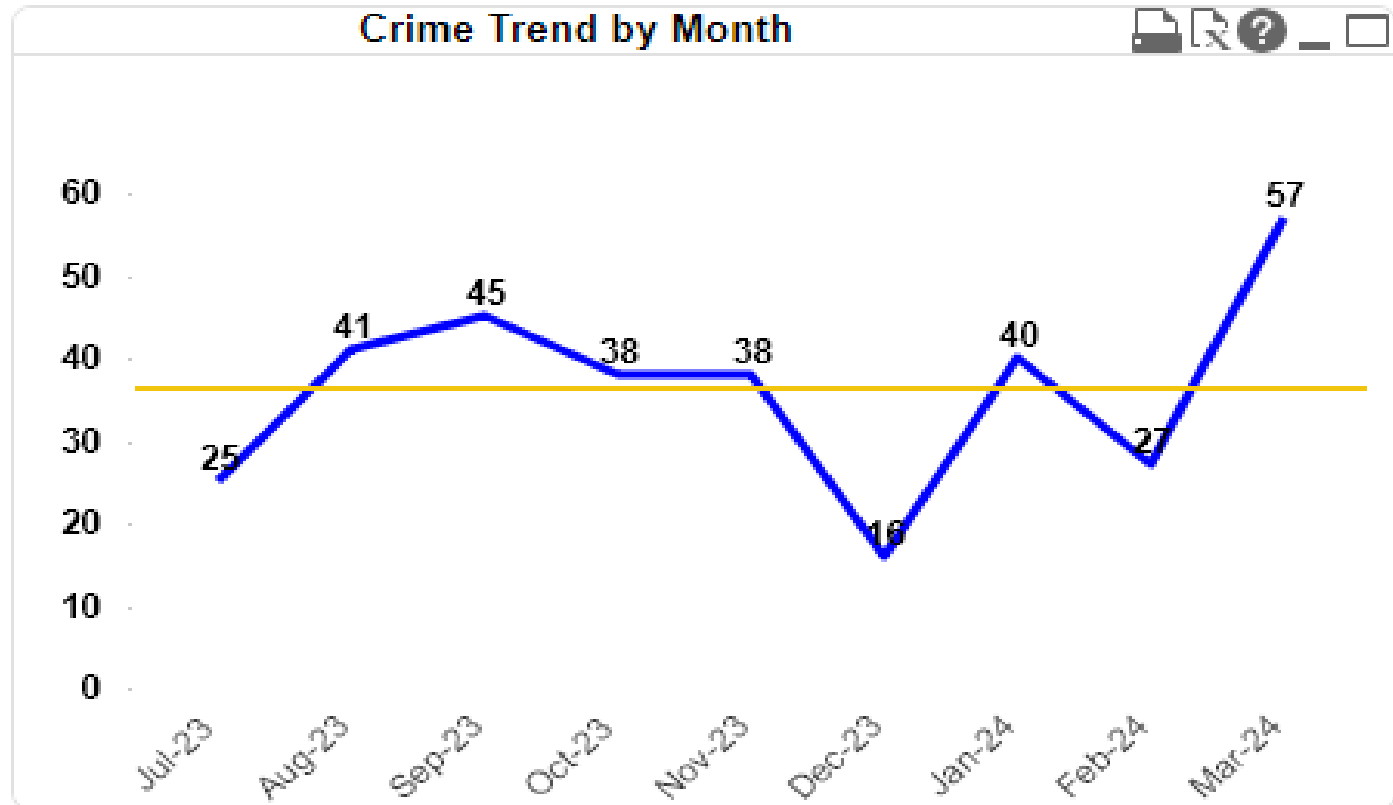

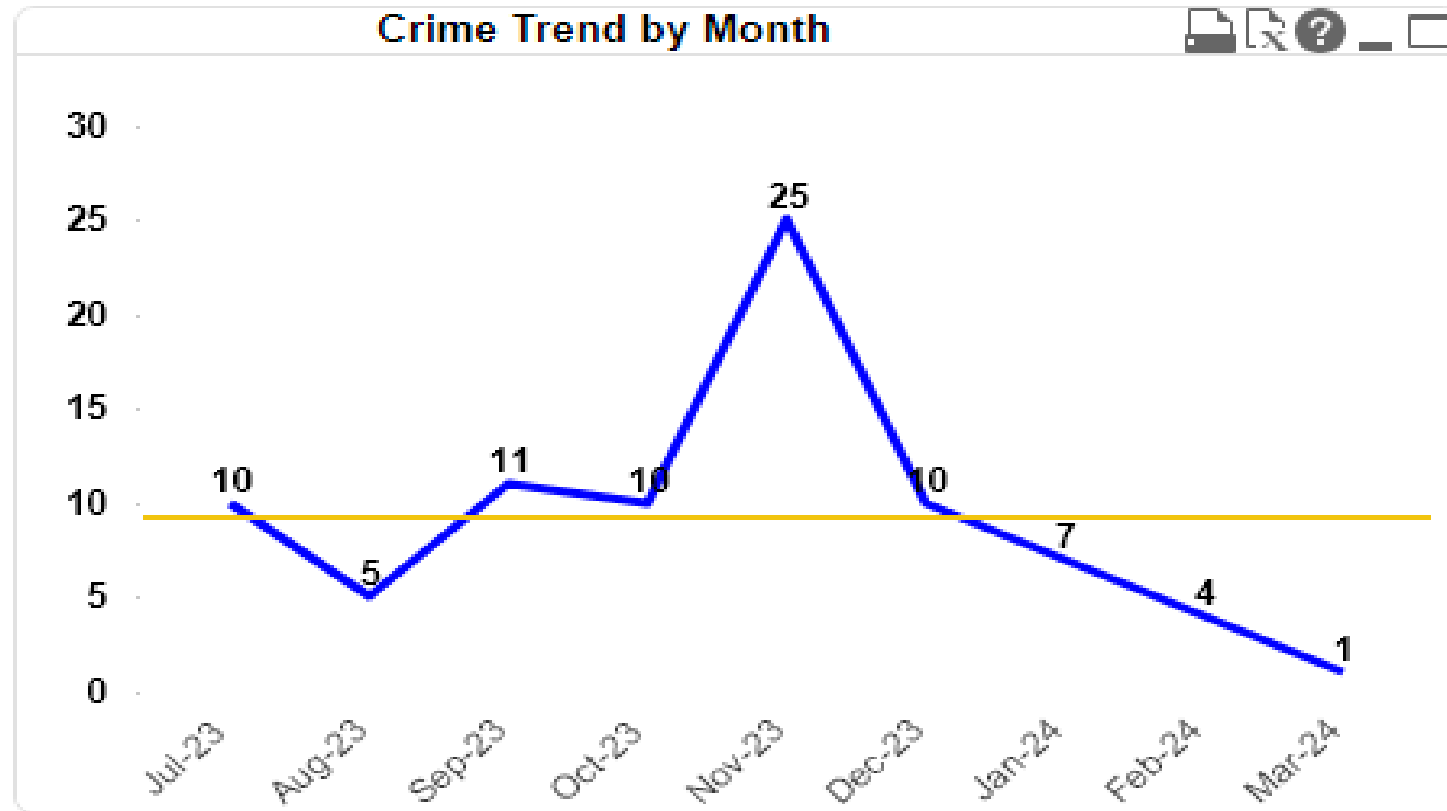

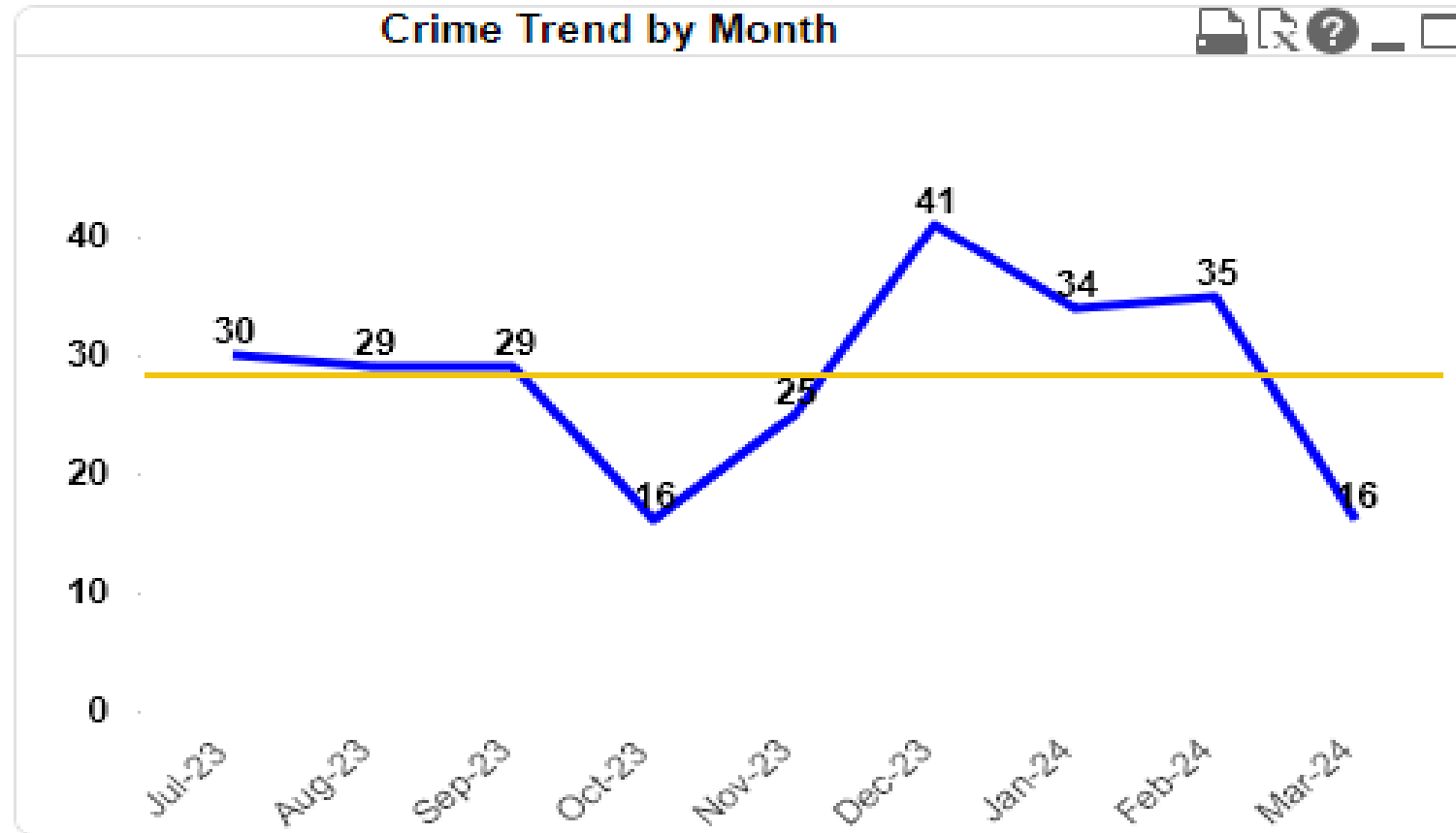

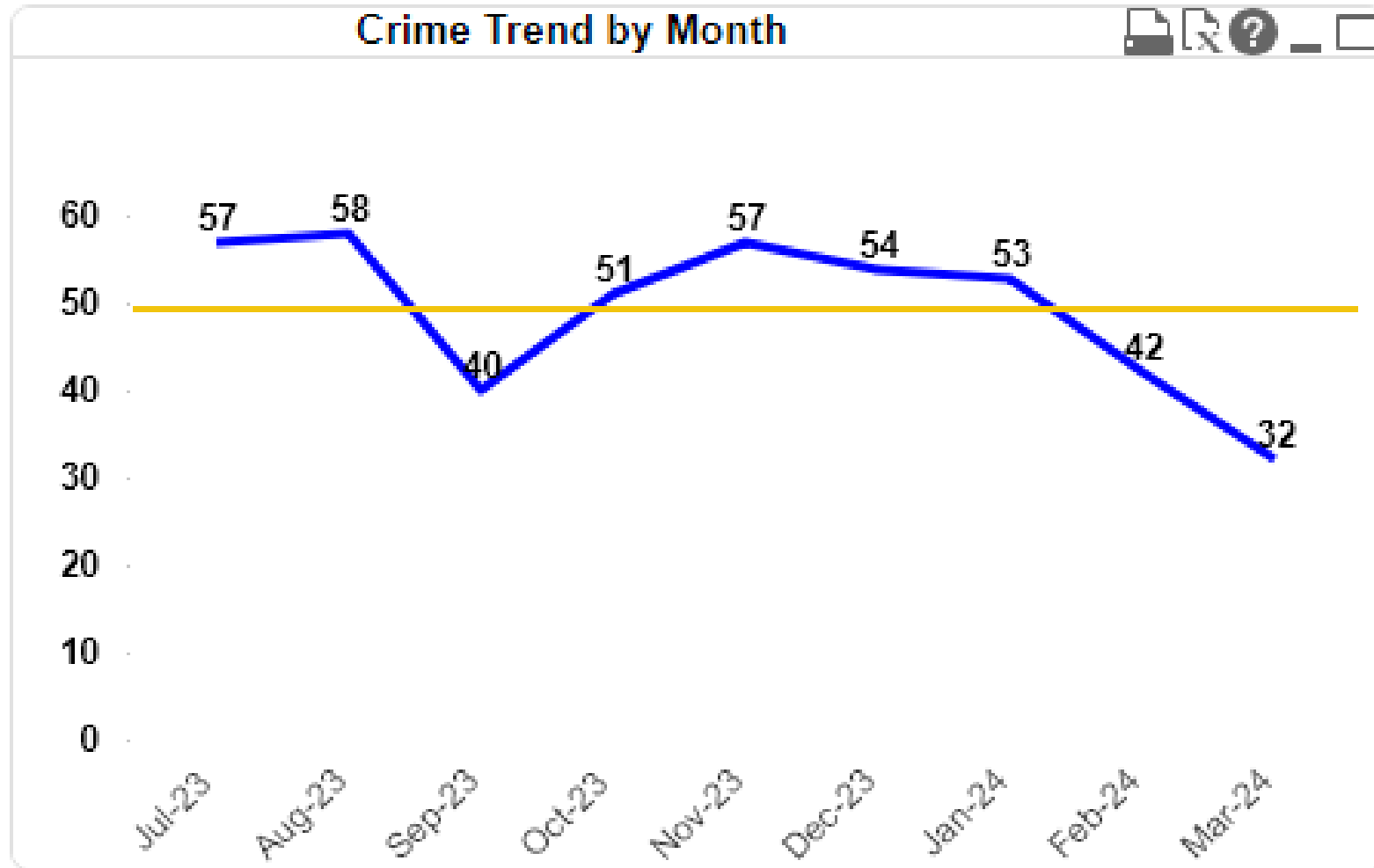
Commercial Burglaries



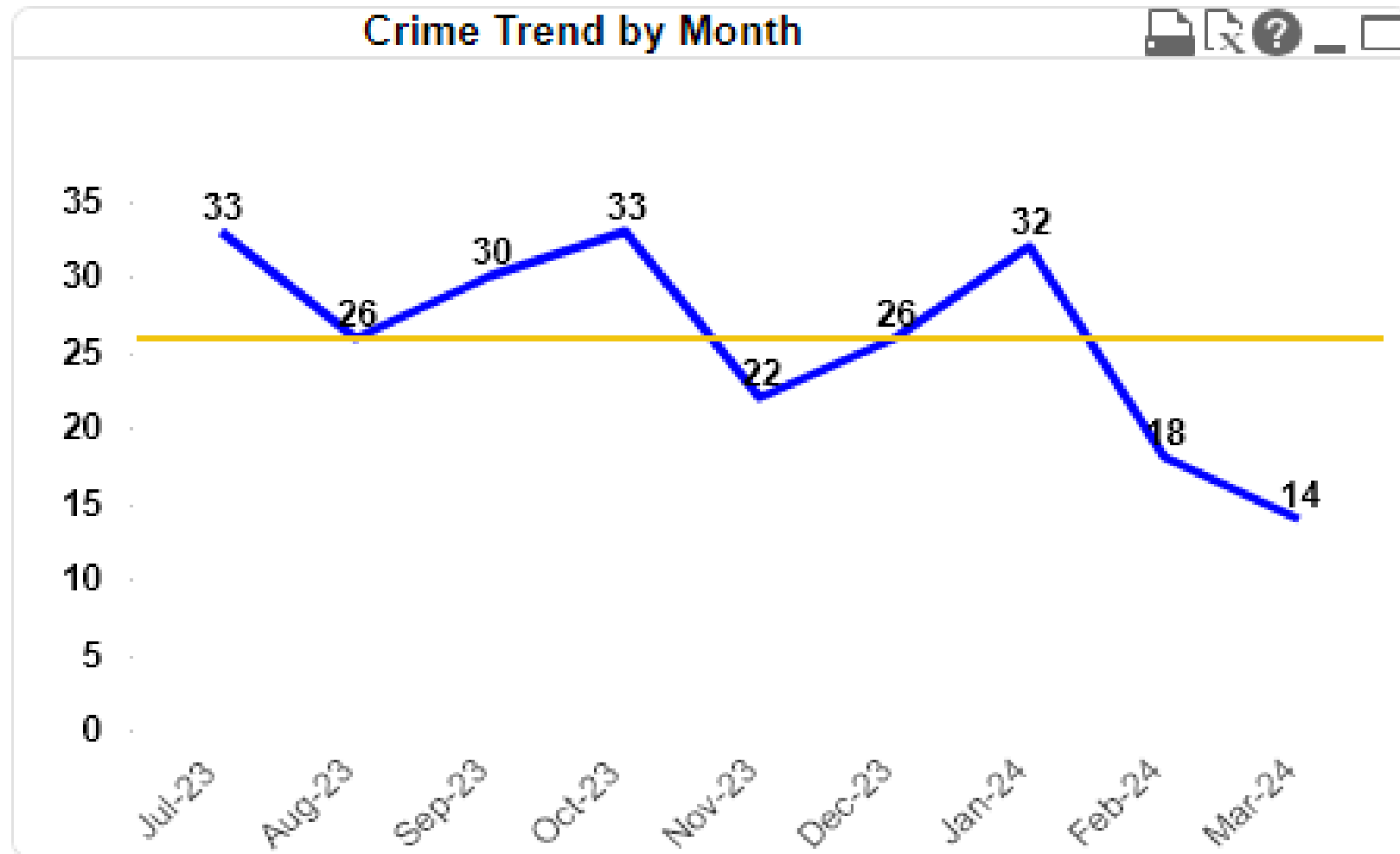
Violence with injury



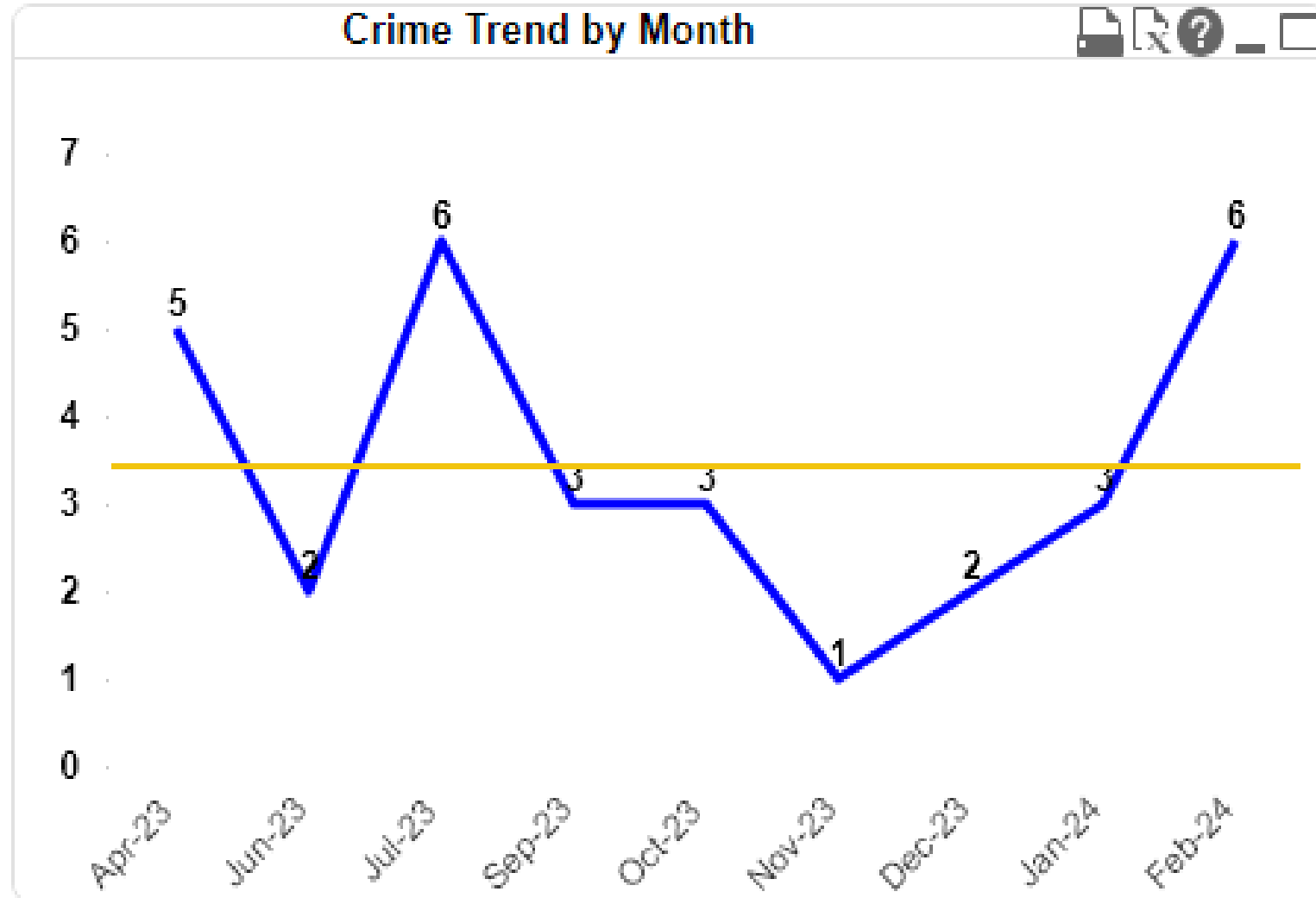
Violence without injury
